Planning update

Garden Close (reserved matters)

A meeting of the Planning Committee at the end of April voted by six votes to three to refuse the application by Abbey Homes for the detail of its plans for the development at Garden Close.

Three reasons were given for the refusal, including non-compliance with Sutton Neighbourhood Plan policies 5 ('predominantly low density single-storey dwellings') and 7 ('Housing development must contribute to meeting the needs of the village').
